We also work tirelessly for a sustainable and green future, which enabled us to place in the UI GreenMetric ranking. We have outstanding academic and administrative staff members and high-level physical facilities, which we use to establish and disseminate a quality culture.

Two characteristic features make our University unique: First, the balanced spread of all academic units, from dentistry to communication and from theology to engineering. OMU, which is among the 50 most entrepreneurial and innovative universities in our country, has started quality-oriented revision studies in education as of 2020. It is envisaged that the revision works will be completed by the end of 2022 by systematizing the revision guideline associated with the YÖKAK quality criteria.

Our University is in the top five in our country regarding the number of international students. There are nearly 6,000 students from 120 different countries at our University. In this context, OMU, taking firm steps forward in terms of internationalization, has been successfully carrying out the University Entrance Exam for International Students (YÖS) since 2012. To date, exams have been held in 95 different exam centres in 52 countries with nine language options. Candidates who want to study in our country have been brought together with our University and other higher education institutions.

OMU has taken the first concrete step in the research and development policies put forward by the rectorate by gathering the R&D centres under one roof. OMU has crowned this progress with the accreditation of The Black Sea Advanced Technology Research and Application Center (KITAM) and implementation of the web-based automation system.



What Do We Do for R&D?

Our University has implemented the OMÜLingo online mobile language learning platform, which helps its students to learn languages. OMU has developed the TEKNOMÜ project to prepare for TEKNOFEST. In addition, OMU strengthened its steps by increasing the financial support that undergraduate students can use in their research projects.



Our success story; which progressed with the return of our academics with one gold, two silver and two bronze medals from ISIF2020 (International Inventions Fair) and one gold, two silver and four bronze medals from ISIF2021; has resulted in the success of our University in inventions and projects with the achievements of our entrepreneurs and students.

Our University, which helps the plant find its commercial value through the Cannabis Research Institute, continues to pioneer the region with its studies. Our University also organized the Middle Black Sea Career Fair (OKAF) in a short time with great success and organized the first career fair of 2022 in Samsun. At OKAF, hosted by OMU, 202 companies, 10 thousand students and 15 thousand visitors were brought together in 75 career events.

In addition, OMU, which tries to make Samsun a brand in water buffalo products, provides the city's people with new recreational facilities and recreation areas and provides service to the entire region with the successful work of the medical faculty.

Besides, our University has signed 251 protocols and collaborations with external stakeholders in the last five years. These include a broad scope from the "Vocational Counseling Service Model for University Students: Job Club" realized with İŞKUR to the protocol signed with the Metropolitan Municipality for stray animals.

A Class Competent and Safe Library which won the Access in Space Award, Arabic Language Center (ADİM) which is the first independent centre, Women and Society Application and Research Center (OKTAM), Health Application and Research Center (SUVAM), Developmental Education Application and Research Center (OGEM) which won the Access in Space award, OMU Psychology Application and Research Center (PUAMER), Medicine and Dentistry Hospitals where tens of thousands of patients are treated every day, the selflessly working Animal Hospital which is a unit of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, and the OMU Foundation can be listed among the resources that our University fulfils its duties to the society.

With 83 companies, 453 personnel and 102 ongoing projects it hosts, TEKNOPARK and Technology Transfer Office (TTO), the bridge that enables cooperation between our University and industry, plays a vital role in fulfilling one of our most significant duties towards society.



Faculty of Education offers education in eight departments: Educational Sciences Department, Special Education Department, Primary Education Department, Mathematics and Science Education Department, Fine Arts Education Department, Computer and Instructional Technologies Department, Foreign Language Education Department, and Turkish and Social Sciences Education Department. There are English, German, and French Language Teaching Departments in the Department of Foreign Languages. Our graduate students can be employed at public or private schools of the Ministry of National Education. Graduates from the Department of Special Education can work at special education and rehabilitation centers. The students who graduate from the Department of Psychological Counseling and Guidance can work at health and social work institutions and can also establish their own counselling centers.

What Exchange Programs Do We Offer to Our Students?

We have agreements with Farabi, Mevlana, and Erasmus K131 Programme Country Agreements and K171 Partner Country Agreements. Moreover, the Department of Fine Arts Education has exchanged students with Conservatorio Di Musica Luigi Cherubini in Italy, Liszt Ferenc Academi of Music in Hungary, and Universitatea Din Oradea University in Romania in the last ten years. 
The occupational clubs are bound to the faculties, while the social clubs have general qualifications. Our Faculty has transformed professional practices into gains by signing protocols with many official institutions.

There are two types of community structures classified into occupational and social categories within the body of the Directorate of Health, Culture and Sports of our University. Professional societies are specific to faculties, while social societies are general. The students have carried out many activities and organizations within the communities so far. In addition, our University provides the institutional ground necessary to create an atmosphere that will enable the cultural development of the students through social communities operating in 93 fields, from cycling to chess.



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
